

Admission Policy for Allied Health Sciences Programs for the Session 2021-22

The following Admission Policy is formulated to comply with the requirements of affiliating University.

A. Eligibility criteria

Any person seeking admission in RMI Allied Health Sciences Programs shall be eligible having fulfilled the following mandatory criteria.

Rehman College of Nursing

BScN

- Premedical or Equivalent with minimum 50% marks
- Maximum age limit 30 years

Post RN

- 3 years diploma in nursing (RN)
- 1-year Diploma in midwifery/ any post basic specialty
- 1-2 years clinical experience
- Both male and female
- Valid PNC license

Certified Nursing Assistant Program

- Matric (Science) with minimum 50% marks or Matric (Arts) 55% marks
- Maximum age limit 30 years
- Gender: Female Only
- Science group candidates will be preferred

Rehman College of Rehabilitation Sciences

DPT & BS. SLP

- HSSC (pre-medical) or Equivalent minimum 60% marks

Rehman College of Allied Health Sciences

BS Technologies

- HSSC (pre- medical) or Equivalent minimum 50% marks
- Age: maximum 25 years

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B. Merit Weightage

HSSC or equivalent:	50%
KMU-CAT	40%
Interview:	10%

Note:- This weightage is not applicable for Post RN for which internal Entry Test will be held.

C. Merit list

1. The admission to above programs in RMI Allied Health Sciences Programs shall be made strictly based on merit.
2. In case final merit of more than one candidate is equal up to four decimals, the candidate older in age shall stand higher in merit.
3. After the display of final merit list, if there is any vacant seat, next student on merit in the waiting list will be offered admission against such vacant seat.

D. Admission process

1. The applications through online portal of the college shall be accepted for the scrutiny and merit formulation.
2. It will be the responsibility of the candidate to provide all academic & personal documents as required by the college prior to the last date of admissions as specified in the website.
3. Communication to the applicants will be strictly through Email address provided by the applicants
4. Visiting college website for day to day updates will be the responsibility of the applicants.
5. Selected applicants and their parents/guardians will be required to submit an affidavit on a Rs. 100/- stamp paper duly notarized by a notary, stating the acceptance of College required disciplinary, legal, financial responsibilities and all other rules and regulations specified in the college prospectus.
6. Admission will remain conditional subject to verification of all documents, passing medical fitness test.
7. Personal appearance for verification and interview is required.
8. Admission offer will be valid only on fee deposit within the stipulated period given below.
9. In case any seat fall vacant in any AHS program after completion of admission, the applicants on waiting list of other AHS program will be considered for the admission offer of the respective program.
10. In case the seat is not filled by applying (9) above, the same will be re-advertised.



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E. Payment of College Fee


The selected applicants shall be bound to deposit fee within three working days failing which the admission offer shall automatically stand withdrawn and next candidate on merit will be issued admission offer.

F. General provisions


- Regulatory Authorities directives regarding admissions 2021 – 22 issued from time to time will be followed






